After praying, I feel it is right to let you know we have a shortfall in the *Joy in the Harvest* General Fund. Our General Fund is the backbone of this ministry. All salaries, general expenses, and every project depend on it. It is crucial to the health and future of the work.

We have cut expenses, but it is clear that unless we receive a "bump up" in giving for this year, and an increase in future income of about 15%, we will have to curtail important programs. That will impact the poor and I do not want to see that happen!
